



SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT FOR
NORTH ATLANTIC STATES CARPENTERS VACATION FUND

This is a summary of the annual report of the North Atlantic States Carpenters Vacation Fund, Employer Identification Number 04-3322721, Plan No. 501, for the period of January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024. The Fund is a multiemployer, collectively bargained welfare employee benefit plan. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENT

The value of plan assets, after subtracting the liabilities of the plan, was \$5,751,077 as of December 31, 2024, compared to \$6,058,066 as of January 1, 2024. During the plan year, the plan experienced a decrease in its net assets of \$306,989. During the plan year, the plan had the following:

- Total income of \$23,107,926 from:
 - Participant contributions of \$22,623,655,
 - Earnings from interest on investments of \$484,271.
- Plan expenses were \$23,414,915 from:
 - \$200,582 in administrative expenses, and
 - \$23,214,333 in benefits paid to participants and beneficiaries.

You have the right to receive a copy of the full annual report, or any part thereof, on request. The items listed below are included in that report:

- an accountant's report; and
- financial information and information on payments to service providers.

The charge to cover copying costs will be \$8.00 for the full annual report or \$.25 per page for any part thereof.

You also have the right to receive from the plan administrator, on request and at no charge, a statement of the assets and liabilities of the plan and accompanying notes, or a statement of income and expenses of the plan and accompanying notes, or both. If you request a copy of the full annual report from the plan administrator, these two statements and accompanying notes will be included as part of that report. The charge to cover copying costs given above does not include a charge for the copying of these portions of the report because these portions are furnished without charge.

You also have the legally protected right to examine the annual report at the main office of the plan, 350 Fordham Road, Wilmington, Massachusetts, 01887, and at the U. S. Department of Labor in Washington, D.C., or to obtain a copy from the U. S. Department of Labor upon payment of copying costs.
