SUMMARY

The North Atlantic States Carpenters Benefit Funds (NASCBF) is responsible for the benefit plan operation for Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Maine, New Hampshire, Vermont, and New York State (excluding NYC). We support approximately 24,000 active members and 23,000 retirees. The NASCBF administers three retirement plans, a self-insured/self-administered health plan, and a vacation savings plan. The Collections Manager will work closely with and provide direction to the Data Entry Specialist including fulfilling such operational duties for part of each day.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Process and reconcile payroll contribution reports submitted by employers / contractors in the Fund database.
- Respond to incoming phone calls and emails from members or contractors about the process.
- Maintains accurate records of employer / contractor benefit reporting
- Responsible for receiving, sorting, and date-stamping contributions daily.
- Scanning and indexing required documents.
- Assist contractors with accessing and navigating Fund Office digital platforms and websites, and password maintenance on the Fund's electronic payroll reporting system.
- Various other duties as required.

EDUCATION and/or EXPERIENCE

- Post-secondary education (minimum high school diploma) or equivalent experience (five years or more of comparable office experience)
- Prior data entry, recordkeeping, and payroll reporting experience preferred.
- Strong working knowledge of processing systems, including Microsoft Office – Word and Excel.
- Excellent interpersonal, customer service, and communication skills; ability to interact effectively with internal staff and external clients.

REQUIREMENTS

- Strong math and analytic skills.
- Ability to multitask and change focus quickly.
- Detail oriented.
- Dependability and consistent attendance are important components of the position.
- Sitting at a desk for long periods of time.
- Ability to work in a team environment and willingness to cross train in other areas.
- Bilingual abilities are a plus
